

WELCOME TO BSA PACK 36 TRAVELERS REST, SC

Mission:

To offer boys a foundation to the boy scouting experience and learning Boy Scout values through fun.

Fiscal Year:

Pack Year is September 1st – August 31st Council/Charter year is January 1st – December 31st

Youth Registration:

- Must be a minimum of 6 years old or in grade K-5 through 11 years old or in 5th grade.
- Must complete BSA youth application *prior* to participating in any scout events (meeting, outings, etc.) or working on any rank advancements.
- **No** youth will be denied registration based on race, ethnicity, religious belief, inability to pay, etc. Please see the Cubmaster if you feel you may have issues paying registration or dues. We want **all** boys to have the opportunity to be a part of Cub Scouts.
- Yearly dues = \$75.00 (\$25.00 goes directly to council for charter remainder used for advancement patches/belt loops, events, supplies, etc.) **Please Note:** new members will have an additional fee that will cover their registration and their designated den handbook.
- 2nd scout = \$50.00/ 3rd scout = \$25.00 dues.
- Dues are payable in full sum or monthly payments (Sept Dec)
- Dues must be paid by December 1st.

Adult Registration:

- Any adult may register as a committee member or any leader/assistant leader position if there is a need. Please ask the Cubmaster/Assistant Cubmaster what is available.
- Must complete a BSA adult application and complete Youth Protection, This Is Scouting and den leader specific online training. Youth Protection Training must be completed *prior* to participating in any scout outings (camps, day trips, hikes, etc.)
- No adult will be denied registration based on race, ethnicity, religious beliefs, etc; however, the Pack reserves the right to dismiss an adult from the Pack if Scouting values & expectations are not demonstrated or respected.
- Yearly dues = \$25.00 (full amount goes directly to council for recharter). Please note, if you are a new leader, it will be an additional \$2.00/month from the time you fill out the out the BSA Adult Registration form until December 31st.
- Dues are payable in full sum or monthly payments (Sept Dec) must be paid by Dec. 1st.

Active Participation:

Active Pack participation is defined as at least 6 months in rank and payment of dues. Scouts may take "time off" for other activities. Please know that any activities completed at den/pack meetings that are missed will have to be made up at home and parents will have to make sure that the den leader is notified of date completed so that record can be made in Scoutbook.

Rank Advancements:

Cub Scouts are ranked based on age or grade, so they can work individually but most of the requirements will be completed at meetings and outings. Only leaders can sign off on requirements earned.

Rank Achievements:

Each rank has a set of required achievements that must be completed and at least one elective achievement in order to complete. All parents/guardians will have limited access to Scoutbook so that they may view and input completed achievement requirement dates.

Scout Accounts:

Each scout will have an individual account tracking all fees due & payments made. Receipts for any monies paid will also be given. At any time, parents may inquire about scout accounts, balances due or credits. If there are any concerns about financial issues, family members should speak directly to the Cubmaster. All concerns will be kept confidential.

Fundraising:

Several fundraisers are planned throughout the year. Participation is optional; however, most fundraisers will allow scouts to earn funds to apply directly to dues and/or other Scouting events (ie. Greenville Swamp Rabbit games, Monster Truck Rally, Greenville Drive games, etc.)

Adult Leader/Committee Member Training:

Throughout the year, council holds various training opportunities for registered adults. If you choose to participate in any of these training sessions, please know that the pack will pay for 50% of the training.
